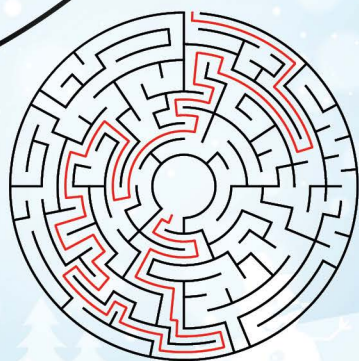
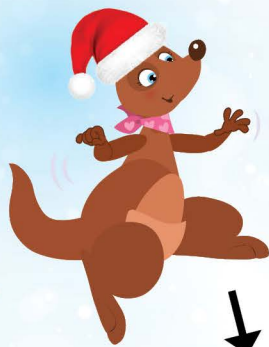

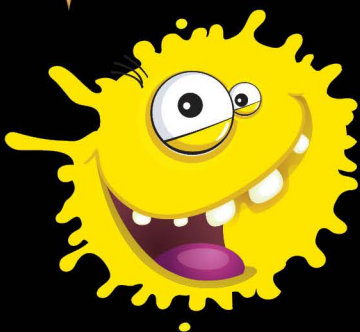






## Question
